Secondary Reading Comprehension and Writing

Entrelíneas offers an entertaining **variety of text types** for the four grade level secondary courses grades 7 - 10. Students will read different text types, they will improve their reading comprehension by learning **reading strategies** and will be able to author their own texts based on the text type they read and comprehend.



They will simultaneously learn how to improve their achievement on reading comprehension assessments, and be able to transfer these skills to their reading of a variety of text types in English.

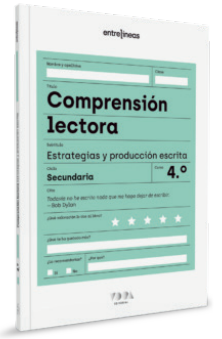

What are the program benefits?

The reading of a variety of text types

Each unit uses an interesting text type appropriate for the age level to read and comprehend and use as a model for writing text.



Reading Comprehension Activities

Before, during and after reading, questions are posed to dig deeper into the ideas central to the text type with the 11 reading strategies of the PISA comprehension processes.

The Writing Challenge

The unit ends with a writing product assignment that synthesizes all of the learning in the unit to accomplish at home or in the classroom on a regular basis. Units employ the practice of having students work on the ideas presented in the various text types in small groups in these activities: dialogues, debates, interviews, analysis of the context, etc.

The PISA instructional processes are those proposed by David Ausubel.

BEFORE: These are activities to tap background knowledge, reflect on the title of the text to know some of the characteristics of the genre.

DURING: These are two or three activities that interrupt the reading of the text so that students make predictions or clarify words they do not understand.

AFTER: These are seven activities to deepen their understanding of the text. Students will discover explicit and implicit information and they will be able to connect what they have read to their own experience.
